of Cavalry - He now Commands a Georgia Brigade
of 5 Regts. The 1st 2nd 3rd 4th & 6th E. Cav. in my Division
South of Austin - Department of the Cavalry in East Texas
Brigade & I assume the Command of my Division. He
with other officers has highly recommended Col Crew
for promotion to the grade of Brigadier.

RECORD
The ~~same~~ under Col Crew as well as the officers
have a high regard for him. He is brave, intelligent
prompt, & always at his post. I was present on
the 24th of this month when at Wadley with less
than five hundred men he fought & routed a brigade
of 1000. Chas. Cavalry & took one of the pieces of
Artillery - On the 29th inst with some 750 of his
men I saw him drive double that force of
the Enemy's infantry of the 9th Army Corps & the same
day with his Brigade mounted he covered the retreat
of the Cavalry without a Companion though assailed by
5 times his force - I heartily recommend his promotion
