Now live in NE VA on the lower Potomac River near the Chesapeake Bay, retired US Navy. My descent from "Yankee Dave" Hickox is via his son Jonathan David, his son David Eugene, his son William Harley, and his son Oscar Jonathan, (Sr.). My mother was a Culbreth from Waycross. They lived until I was close to being grown and we spent many hours talking about the family and its many interesting experiences during their life-times.
